Subject: Implementation of Pay Scale for University and College Teachers as per 7th Pay Commission recommendations for Teachers and Equivalent Cadres.

Sir,

You are aware that quite a few states across the country have started implementing new pay scale for Teachers and equivalent cadres in Universities and Colleges as per the recommendations of 7th Pay Commission. In this connection we draw your kind attention to Ministry of Human Resource Development, Department of Higher Education, Letter No. F-1-1/2018-U.II Dated 26th July, 2018 New Delhi in which The Education Secretaries of all State Governments had been informed that central financial assistance would be reimbursed to those state governments opting to revise pay scales of teachers and other equivalent cadre covered under the scheme notified by the Ministry vide letter No. 1-7/2015-U.II (1) dated 2nd November, 2017 and 8th November, 2017.

In view of this West Bengal College and University Teachers Association demand immediate implementation of 7th Pay Scale in the State.

We are extremely disgusted to say that despite our repeated appeal to competent authorities the last installment of arrear pertaining to 6th Pay Scale for the College and University teachers and equivalent cadres have not been released as yet.

WBCUTA will therefore be forced to go for larger movements unless the outstanding arrear of the 6th Pay Commission is not released in addition to immediate implementation of the new pay scale.
