Subject: Immediate implementation of revision of pay of (a) teachers and equivalent cadres and (b) administrative posts in universities and colleges following the revision of pay scales of Central Govt employees on the recommendation of the 7th Central Pay Commission [F.No. 23-4/2017(P.S.)] dated 31st January, 2018.

Sir,

West Bengal College and University Teachers' Association demands immediate implementation of the recommendation of the 7th Pay Commission for the teachers and equivalent cadres in University and College teachers in view of the letter [F.No. 23-4/2017(P.S.)] dated 31st January, 2018 sent by Mr. P.K. Thakur, Secretary UGC sent by Speed Post to the Education Secretaries of all the States across the country for necessary action towards implementation of CPC. The letter clearly states that the state Governments may initiate immediate action so that the implementation of this scheme may be done in a time bound manner.

It is also a matter of concern to us that when University Grants Commission is issuing letter to the state governments to implement the new Pay Scale forthwith, the College and University teachers of our state are still to receive a portion of their arrear pertaining to the previous pay scale.

Sir, we had submitted a letter to Hon'ble MIC, Higher Education [Ref. No.. WB/EM/-5(17)] dated 12th December, 2017 requesting implementation of the new scale in view of the MHRD ORDER NO. 1-7/2015-U.II (1) dated 2nd November, 2017 alongwith necessary provisions for revision of pension for all the retired university and college teachers. The letter of UGC further justifies our demand. West Bengal College and University Teachers' Association will be left with no other option but to launch a strong movement in order to attain our justified demand.

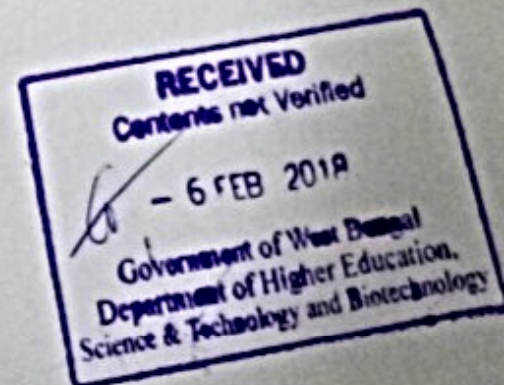
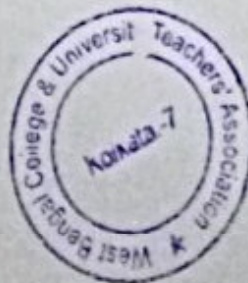
